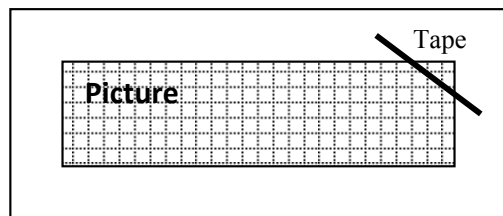

These directions must be followed!

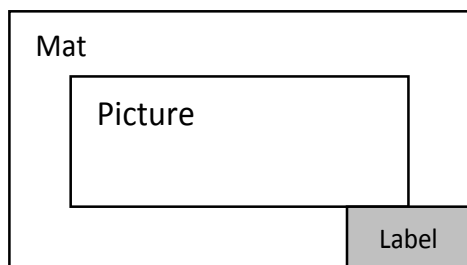
1. Due to limited space, submit only one (1) art work per participant.
2. Choose only the best work. Do not send multiples of the same project.
3. Flatwork not to exceed 18" x 24".
4. Lightweight mats only. NO FRAMES OR GLASS will be accepted.
5. Art must be held in the mat with cellophane tape or masking tape.
6. Art work without a label cannot be accepted.
7. Inside of mat should overlap the picture at least 1/4 inch.
8. Tape must be placed at right angles on mat. DO NOT put tape parallel with mat, as it will peel off.



Labeling and Packaging

To assist in the return of art work:

1. Entries cannot be accepted unless an official label is used. (see sample in next column)
2. Place label in lower right hand corner of picture.
3. Package art work by school/organization, including name of school district, and number of pieces enclosed on the outside of each package. If more than one package is used, please label them package #1 of 2, #2 of 2, etc. Private schools must include their city, phone, and contact name.
